

## Programme O. VERIFICATION IN IRAQ PURSUANT TO UNSC RESOLUTIONS

**Problems and issues to be addressed by the Agency:**

The work under this programme is based on: United Nations Security Council Resolutions (UNSCR) 661 (1990); UNSCR 687 (1991); UNSCR 707 (1991); UNSCR 715 (1991); UNSCR 986 (1995); UNSCR 1051 (1996); UNSCR 1154 (1998); UNSCR 1284 (1999), and UNSCR 1330 (2000).

**Objectives:** To provide credible assurance that Iraq is complying with the provisions of UNSCR 687 (1991) and other relevant resolutions.

Outcome
— Assurance provided to the UNSC of the absence of prohibited equipment, materials and activities, and timely detection of any such items or activities.
Performance Indicators
— Level of credible assurance of the absence of evidence of proscribed activities in Iraq. — Basis of credible assurance in semi-annual reports to the UNSC and other documents.

### Subprogramme O.1. Verification in Iraq pursuant to UNSC Resolutions

**Programme changes and trends:** The Agency's activities in Iraq from 1991 to 1998 produced a technically coherent picture of Iraq's clandestine nuclear programme. If, after resuming its verification activities in Iraq, the Agency could satisfy itself that Iraq's past and present nuclear activities and nuclear assets have not changed since December 1998, the Agency will focus its resources on the implementation and strengthening of the technical content of its activities under the Ongoing Monitoring and Verification (OMV) plan. It will, however, continue to exercise its right to investigate any aspect of Iraq's clandestine nuclear programme and to destroy, remove or render harmless any prohibited items discovered through such investigations.

**Resource changes and trends:** All resources will derive from the United Nations Special Fund.

**Project O.1.01: Ongoing monitoring and verification (OMV) operations**

**Main outputs:** This project will result in reports of monitoring inspections from the field, supported by video tapes and other remote sensor data and analysed samples.

**Duration:** This is an ongoing activity, unless UNSC decides otherwise.

**Ranking:** 1 ex æquo (mandatory)

**Project O.1.02: Development, support and planning**

**Main outputs:** This project will develop new field tools and the overall information system, and provide the necessary information technology structure and support services in the field. This project will also implement the IAEA's Plan for Ongoing Monitoring and Verification (OMV), including the human and budgetary requirements, and will provide reports to the UNSC and the Agency's General Conference.

**Duration:** This is an ongoing activity, unless UNSC decides otherwise.

**Ranking:** 1 ex æquo (mandatory)

**Project O.1.03: Management**

**Main outputs:** This project is needed to provide adequate management of the resources of Programme O.

**Duration:** This is an ongoing activity, unless UNSC decides otherwise.

**Ranking:** 1 ex æquo (essential)
