**Committee  
of the Whole  
7<sup>th</sup> meeting**

The Committee convened at 10.00 a.m. and considered the three agenda items still outstanding, which were taken up in the following order:

**Item 13**

The Committee returned to the issue of “Transport Safety” on which open ended informal consultations had been conducted over several days, the results of which were contained in draft resolution GC(46)/COM.5/L.13. The Committee agreed to recommend that it be adopted.

**Item 16**

On item 16 of the agenda, “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of the safeguards system and application of the Model Additional Protocol” for which draft resolution GC(46)/COM.5/L.7/Rev.1 was tabled, the Committee was not able to agree on a draft resolution. It agreed that the Chairman would report this to the Conference in his oral report.

**Item 5(c)**

The Committee reverted to item 5(c) of the agenda, “Restoration of voting rights”, for which document GC(46)/20 had been prepared. The Committee agreed that the Chairman recommend to the Conference that it requests the Board to consider the criteria, guidelines and measures being applied in connection with requests for the restoration of voting rights, and in particular the requirements for payment plans and to deal with the matter at its June 2003 meetings following the meetings of the Programme and Budget Committee in May 2003.

The Committee of the Whole adjourned its final session.

**Plenary  
9<sup>th</sup> meeting**

The Conference convened at 10.00 a.m. with a summary presentation by the Rapporteur of the Scientific Forum. It then adjourned until 12.00 noon to allow the Committee of the Whole to conclude its work.

**Item 18**

When the Conference reconvened, it took up item 18 of the agenda, “Implementation of the NPT safeguards agreement between the Agency and the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea”, and adopted draft resolution GC(46)/L.2;

**Item 20**

The Conference then turned to item 20 of the agenda, “Application of IAEA safeguards in the Middle East”, and adopted draft resolution GC(46)/L.1;

**Item 21**

Before it adjourned its morning session, the Conference dealt with item 21 of the agenda, “Israeli nuclear capabilities and threat”, and endorsed a Statement that the President read to the Conference.

**Plenary  
10<sup>th</sup> meeting**

**Item 19**

The Conference resumed with item 19 of the agenda, “Implementation of United Nations Security Council resolutions relating to Iraq” and adopted the draft resolution contained in document GC(46)/L.3, with a roll call vote.

**Oral Report by the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole**

As recommended by the Committee of the Whole, the Conference adopted:

**Item 13** - Draft resolution GC(46)/L.7, “Measures to strengthen international co-operation in nuclear, radiation, transport and waste safety”;

**Item 14** - Draft resolution GC(46)/L.5, “Strengthening of the Agency’s technical co-operation activities”;

**Item 15** - Draft resolution GC(46)/L.6, “Strengthening the Agency’s activities related to nuclear science, technology and applications”;

**Item 16** - Draft resolution GC(46)/COM.5/L.7/Rev.1, “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of the safeguards system and application of the Model Additional Protocol”;

**Item 17** - Draft resolution GC(46)/L.4, “Nuclear security – progress on measures to protect against nuclear terrorism”;

**Item 5(c)** - “Restoration of voting rights”, the Conference accepted the recommendation by the Committee to request the Board to consider the criteria, guidelines and measures being applied in connection with requests for the restoration of voting rights, and in particular the requirements for payment plans and to deal with the matter at its June 2003 meetings following the meetings of the Programme and Budget Committee in May 2003.

**Item 22** – “Election to the Agency’s Staff Pension Committee”, the Conference accepted the recommendation of the Committee to elect Mr. Aidan KIRWAN of Ireland and Mr. Raul PELÁEZ of Argentina to represent the General Conference as Alternate Members of the Agency’s Staff Pension Committee.

**Item 24**

With regard to the “Report on contributions pledged to the Technical Co-operation Fund for 2003”, all delegations which have not yet done so were urged to make their 2003 pledges and to pay their contributions in full at the earliest opportunity.

The President expressed his gratitude for the cooperation and assistance extended to him and for the valuable support, which enabled the successful completion of the work of the Conference.
