

**Recurrent project: Overall management, co-ordination and common activities**

Co-ordination and advisory activities within Major Programme 2 relate to and interact with the constituent programmes and subprogrammes and are important in achieving efficiency and effective programme implementation. Co-ordination on technical issues is necessary with relevant activities in Major Programmes 1, 3 and 6, and for managerial issues with Major Programmes 5 and 7. Cross-cutting areas, dealing in particular with environment and quality control, are especially important. Co-ordination is also necessary in the preparation of documents such as the *Nuclear Technology Review*

and *Annual Report*, for the preparation of policy documents and reviews for the Board of Governors and General Conference, and for support to the Standing Advisory Group on Nuclear Applications (SAGNA).
