## Committee of the Whole

### 7<sup>th</sup> meeting

The Committee convened at 11.00 a.m. and considered the two agenda items still outstanding, which were taken up in the following order:

#### **Item 23**

The Committee returned to the issue of “Amendment to Article VI of the Statute”, on which informal consultations had been conducted and the text of a recommendation for Conference action was agreed.

#### **Item 17**

On agenda item 17, “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of the safeguards system and application of the Model Additional Protocol”, the Committee before it the revised draft resolution GC(47)/COM.5/L.17/Rev.1 submitted by the Chair of the Working Group on Safeguards, and the draft resolution GC(47)/COM.5/L.3 originally distributed. The Committee unfortunately was not able to agree on a draft resolution and therefore recommended that the Chairman report this to the Conference in his oral report.

The Committee of the Whole adjourned its final session.

## Plenary

### 9<sup>th</sup> meeting

The Conference convened at 12.15 a.m. and took up the remaining agenda items in the following order:

*(Note: all views expressed by delegations will be fully reflected in the summary records).*

#### **Item 24**

The Conference took up agenda item 24, “Examination of delegates’ credentials” and adopted the draft resolution contained in paragraph 8 of document GC(47)/24.

#### **Item 18**

The Conference then turned to agenda item 18, “Implementation of the NPT safeguards agreement between the Agency and the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea”, and adopted draft resolution GC(47)/L.4 without a vote.

#### **Item 19**

On this agenda item, “Implementation of United Nations Security Council resolutions relating to Iraq”, the Conference endorsed a Statement that was read by the President.

#### **Oral Report by the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole:**

The Chairman of the Committee of the Whole completed his report to the Conference on the agenda items referred to it.

Before the Conference adjourned its morning session, the Rapporteur of the Scientific Forum made a report.

### 10<sup>th</sup> meeting

The Conference reconvened at 3.30 p.m. with the adoption of the draft resolutions recommended to it by the Committee of the Whole and the remaining items on its agenda, namely:

#### **Item 13**

Clustered draft resolution GC(46)/L.7, “Measures to strengthen international co-operation in nuclear, radiation and transport safety and waste management”, was adopted.

#### **Item 14**

Draft resolution GC(47)/L.8, “Nuclear security – measures to protect against nuclear terrorism”, was adopted.

**Item 15**

Draft resolution GC(47)/L.9, “Strengthening of the Agency’s technical co-operation activities”, was adopted.

**Item 16**

Clustered draft resolution GC(47)/L.5, “Strengthening the Agency’s activities related to nuclear science, technology and applications”, was adopted.

**Item 17**

Draft resolution GC(47)/COM.5/L.17/Rev.1, “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of the safeguards system and application of the Model Additional Protocol”, was adopted without a vote (a vote was taken on operative paragraph 3 only).

**Item 22**

Clustered draft resolution GC(47)/L.6, “Personnel”, was adopted.

**Item 23**

Under this agenda item, “Amendment to Article VI of the Statute”, the Conference agreed to the action recommended by the Committee of the Whole.

**Item 20**

Draft resolution GC(47)/L.3, “Application of IAEA safeguards in the Middle East”, was adopted without a vote.

**Item 21**

With regard to this agenda item, “Israeli nuclear capabilities and threat”, the Conference endorsed a statement that was read by the President.

**Item 25**

With regard to the “Report on contributions pledged to the Technical Co-operation Fund for 2004”, all delegations which had not yet done so were urged to make their 2004 pledges and to pay their contributions in full at the earliest opportunity.

The President expressed his gratitude for the co-operation and assistance extended to him and for the valuable support which enabled the successful completion of the work of the Conference.
