## Plenary

### 9<sup>th</sup> meeting

The Conference convened at 12.00 noon and on its final day dealt with the following:

It adopted all the draft resolutions and decisions, which had been recommended and reported to it by the Committee of the Whole, without a vote, except where otherwise indicated:

**Item 10** - “The Agency’s Accounts for 2004”

- adopted the draft resolution on page Roman I of document GC(49)/7.

**Item 11** - “The Agency’s Budget for 2005 — supplementary appropriation”

- adopted the draft resolution in the Annex of document GC(49)/8 entitled “Supplementary Budget Appropriation for 2005”.

**Item 12** - “The Agency’s Programme and Budget for 2006-2007”

- adopted the draft resolutions clustered in the Annex to document GC(49)/2, namely,
  - A. “Regular Budget Appropriations for 2006”;
  - B. “Technical Cooperation Fund Allocation for 2006”; and
  - C. “The Working Capital Fund in 2006”.
- adopted the decision set out in document GC(49)/L.2 regarding the “Amendment to Article XIV.A of the Statute”.

**Item 14** - “Scale of assessment of Members’ contributions towards the Regular Budget”

- adopted the draft resolution on page 3 of document GC(49)/16.

**Item 15** - “Measures to strengthen international cooperation in nuclear, radiation and transport safety and waste management”

- adopted the clustered draft resolution contained in GC(49)/L.4, namely,
  - A. “Measures to strengthen international cooperation in nuclear, radiation and transport safety and waste management”; and
  - B. “Transport Safety”.

**Item 16** – “Nuclear security – measures to protect against nuclear terrorism”

- adopted the clustered draft resolution contained in GC(49)/L.7, namely,
  - A. “Progress on measures to protect against nuclear and radiological terrorism”; and
  - B. “Amendment to the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material”.

**Item 17** – “Strengthening of the Agency’s technical cooperation activities”

- adopted the draft resolution contained in GC(49)/L.8.

**Item 18** – “Strengthening the Agency’s activities related to nuclear science, technology and applications”

- adopted the clustered draft resolution contained in GC(49)/L.5, namely,
  - A. “Strengthening the Agency’s activities related to nuclear science, technology and applications”;
  - B. “Use of isotope hydrology for water resources management”;
  - C. “Programme of Action for Cancer Therapy”;
  - D. “Support to the African Union’s Pan African Tsetse and Trypanosomosis Eradication Campaign (AU-PATTEC);
  - E. “Plan for producing potable water economically using small and medium-sized nuclear reactors”;
  - F. “Agency Activities in the Development of Innovative Nuclear Technology”; and
  - G. “Approaches to supporting nuclear power infrastructure development”.

**Item 23** – “Personnel”

- adopted the clustered draft resolution contained in GC(49)/L.3, namely,
  - A. “Staffing of the Agency’s Secretariat”; and
  - B. “Women in the Secretariat”.

**Item 24** – “Amendment to Article VI of the Statute”

- adopted the decision contained in GC(49)/L.6.

**10<sup>th</sup> meeting**

**Item 25** – “Elections to the Agency’s Staff Pension Committee”

- elected Mr Julio Mollinedo CLAROS of Bolivia and Mr Allan WRIGHT of South Africa as alternative members to the Agency’s Staff Pension Committee.

**Item 19** - “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of the safeguards system and application of the Model Additional Protocol”

Operative paragraph 3 of GC(49)/COM.5/L.12/Rev.1 was voted on separately and was approved (79 in favour, 2 against, 1 abstention).

- adopted the draft resolution contained in GC(49)/COM.5/L.12/Rev.1 without a vote.

The Conference reconvened at 4.00 p.m. and concluded its final session by taking up the following remaining items:

**Item 20** - “Implementation of the NPT safeguards agreement between the Agency and the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea”

- adopted the draft resolution contained in GC(49)/L.9, without a vote.

**Item 21** – “Application of IAEA safeguards in the Middle East”

- adopted the draft resolution contained in GC(49)/L.1, without a vote.

**Item 22** - “Israeli nuclear capabilities and threat”

- endorsed a Statement that was read by the President.

**Item 27** - “Report on contributions pledged to the Technical Cooperation Fund for 2006”,

- by 6.00 p.m. on Friday, 30 September, a total of \$10 828 113 or 13.97% of the target for the 2006 Technical Cooperation Fund had been pledged.
