## Committee of the Whole

**7<sup>th</sup> meeting** Under agenda **item 17**, “Strengthening the Agency’s activities related to nuclear science, technology and applications”, the Committee recommended that the General Conference adopt draft resolution GC(50)/COM.5/L.3/Rev.2.

## Plenary

**9<sup>th</sup> meeting** Under agenda **item 19**, “Implementation of the NPT safeguards agreement between the Agency and the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea”, the Conference adopted the draft resolution contained in document GC(50)/L.9, without a vote.

Then the Chairman of the Special Event, Mr Charles Curtis, presented his report.

The Conference adopted the following draft resolutions and decisions, which had been recommended by the Committee of the Whole, without a vote, except where otherwise indicated:

**Item 10** – “The Agency’s Accounts for 2005” — the draft resolution on page “i” of document GC(50)/8;

**Item 11** – “The Agency’s Budget for 2007” — the following draft resolutions:

- A. “Regular Budget Appropriations for 2007”, in the Annex to document GC(50)/6;
- B. “Technical Cooperation Fund Allocation for 2007”, in document GC(50)/6/Mod.1; and
- C. “The Working Capital Fund in 2007”, in the Annex to document GC(50)/6;

**Item 12** – “Amendment to Article XIV.A of the Statute” — the draft decision in document GC(50)/L.4;

**Item 13** – “Scale of assessment of Members’ contributions towards the Regular Budget” — the draft resolution on page 3 of document GC(50)/16;

**Item 14** – “Measures to strengthen international cooperation in nuclear, radiation and transport safety and waste management” — the clustered draft resolutions in document GC(50)/L.5, namely,

- A. “Measures to strengthen international cooperation in nuclear, radiation and transport safety and waste management”, and
- B. “Transport Safety”;

**Item 15** – “Nuclear security – measures to protect against nuclear terrorism” — the draft resolution in document GC(50)/L.3;

**Item 16** – “Strengthening of the Agency’s technical cooperation activities” — the draft resolution in document GC(50)/L.6;

**Item 17** – “Strengthening the Agency’s activities related to nuclear science, technology and applications” — the clustered draft resolutions in document GC(50)/L.7, namely,

- A. “Non-power nuclear applications”,
- B. “Nuclear power applications” ,
- C. “Nuclear knowledge”;

**Item 22** – “Amendment to Article VI of the Statute” — the draft resolution in document GC(50)/L.8;

**Item 23** – “Elections to the Agency’s Staff Pension Committee” — elected Ms Noor Hasnah Mohamed Khairullah of Malaysia and Ms Olivia Preston of the United Kingdom as alternate members to the Agency’s Staff Pension Committee;

**Item 18** – “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of the safeguards system and application of the Model Additional Protocol” — the draft resolution in document GC(50)/COM.5/L.1/Rev.2, after a vote on operative paragraph 3, which was approved by 77 in favour and 3 against, with no abstentions.

**10<sup>th</sup> meeting**

The Conference reconvened and dealt with the following remaining items:

**Item 25** – “Report on contributions pledged to the Technical Cooperation Fund for 2007”, document GC(50)/23/Rev.3.

By Friday, 22 September, a total of \$8 219 514 or 10.27% of the target for the 2007 Technical Cooperation Fund had been pledged.

**Item 20** – “Application of IAEA safeguards in the Middle East”. The Conference adopted the draft resolution contained in document GC(50)/L.1, with a vote.

**Item 21** – “Israeli nuclear capabilities and threat”. The Conference decided to take a vote in accordance with Rule 59 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference on the motion to take no action during the current session with respect to the draft resolution contained in document GC(50)/L.2 and GC(50)/L.2 Add.1 to 4. The result of the vote was 45 in favour, 29 against, with 19 abstentions.
