FRIDAY, 21 SEPTEMBER 2007

Committee of the Whole

7th meeting Under agenda item 15, “Measures to strengthen international cooperation in nuclear, radiation and transport safety and waste management”, the Committee recommended that the General Conference adopt draft resolution GC(51)/L.7;

Under agenda item 16, “Nuclear security — measures to protect against nuclear terrorism”, the Committee recommended that the General Conference adopt draft resolution GC(51)/L.8;

Under agenda item 17, “Strengthening of the Agency’s technical cooperation activities”, the Committee did not reach consensus on draft resolution GC(51)/COM.5/L.1/Rev.1;

Under agenda item 18, “Strengthening the Agency’s activities related to nuclear science, technology and applications”, the Committee recommended that the General Conference adopt draft resolution GC(51)/L.6;

Under agenda item 19, “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of the safeguards system and application of the Model Additional Protocol”, the Committee recommended that the General Conference adopt draft resolution GC(51)/COM.5/L.12/Rev.1 except operative paragraph 3 which was to be voted on in the Plenary;

Under agenda item 24, “Personnel”, the Committee recommended that the General Conference adopt draft resolution GC(51)/L.5.

Plenary

9th meeting **Item 22** — “Israeli nuclear capabilities and threat”. The Conference discussed this item.

The Conference adopted the following draft resolutions and decisions, which had been recommended by the Committee of the Whole, without a vote, except where otherwise indicated:

Item 15 — “Measures to strengthen international cooperation in nuclear, radiation and transport safety and waste management” — the clustered draft resolutions in document GC(51)/L.7, namely,

- A. “Measures to strengthen international cooperation in nuclear, radiation and transport safety and waste management”, and
- B. “Transport safety”;

Item 16 — “Nuclear security — measures to protect against nuclear terrorism” — draft resolution GC(51)/L.8;

Item 17 — “Strengthening of the Agency’s technical cooperation activities” — draft resolution GC(51)/L.9;

Item 18 — “Strengthening the Agency’s activities related to nuclear science, technology and applications” — the clustered draft resolutions in document GC(51)/L.6, namely,

- A. “Non-power nuclear applications”,
- B. “Nuclear power applications”;

Item 19 — “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of the safeguards system and application of the Model Additional Protocol” —draft resolution GC(51)/COM.5/L.12/Rev.1, after a vote on operative paragraph 3, which was approved by 81 in favour and 3 against, with no abstentions. In addition, a vote was requested for the entire resolution, which was approved by 80 in favour and 0 against, with 12 abstentions.

Item 24 — “Personnel” — the clustered draft resolutions in document GC(51)/L.5, namely,

- A. “Staffing of the Agency’s Secretariat”,
- B. “Women in the Secretariat”;

Item 26 — “Report on contributions pledged to the Technical Cooperation Fund for 2008” (document GC(51)/28/Rev.4). By Thursday, 20 September, a total of \$7 272 647 or 9.09% of the target for the 2008 Technical Cooperation Fund had been pledged.

The President expressed his gratitude for the cooperation and assistance extended to him and for the valuable support, which enabled the successful completion of the work of the Conference.
