## SUMMARY OF MEETINGS

**Plenary  
8<sup>th</sup> meeting**

The Conference resumed consideration of item 8 of the agenda, “General debate and Annual Report for 2008”. Statements were made by the delegates of Zambia, Myanmar, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, El Salvador, Namibia, Zimbabwe, Norway, Colombia, Singapore, Bangladesh and Niger.

Under agenda item 27, “Examination of delegates’ credentials”, on which the General Committee presented its report contained in document GC(53)/31, the Conference adopted the draft resolution contained in paragraph 7 of the General Committee’s report, with the reservations and positions expressed in the report.

Dr Srikumar Banerjee, the Chairman of the Scientific Forum, presented the Forum’s Report.

Under agenda item 12, “Appointment of the External Auditor” (document GC(53)/27) the Conference agreed to the appointment of the Vice-President of the German Supreme Audit Institution as the External Auditor for the Agency’s accounts for the financial years 2010 and 2011.

The Committee continued consideration of agenda item 16, “Nuclear security — measures to protect against nuclear terrorism”, and draft resolution GC(53)/COM.5/L.8.

Under agenda item 9, “Election of Members to the Board of Governors”, the following Member States were elected to serve on the Board of Governors during the period 2009–2011: Azerbaijan, Cameroon, Denmark, Kenya, Republic of Korea, Mongolia, Netherlands, Pakistan, Peru, Ukraine and Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.

The Conference concluded consideration of item 8 of the agenda, “General debate and Annual Report for 2008”. Statements were made by Slovakia, Slovenia, Croatia, Palestine and the Sovereign Order of Malta. A statement was made by the Secretary of the Brazilian-Argentine Agency for Accounting and Control of Nuclear Materials (ABACC).

Under agenda item 21, “Application of IAEA safeguards in the Middle East” (document GC(53)/12, Corr. 1 and Add.1) the Conference adopted draft resolution GC(53)/L.2/Rev.1.
