Nikolay V. Arkhangelskiy is the Deputy Head, Department of Nuclear Power and Nuclear Fuel Cycle, Federal Atomic Energy Agency (Rosatom). He has over 30 years experience in nuclear science and engineering, especially in the field of research reactors.

He began his career at RRC “Kurchatov Institute” in Moscow as a nuclear engineer. He worked in the development of several important reactor projects and the fuel for them. His main activity was the investigation of neutron parameters of reactors. He was a leader of several teams during the commissioning of research reactors in Russia and in foreign countries.

Mr. Arkhangelskiy joined Rosatom in January of 1988 as Section Head in the Department of Nuclear Energy. He is responsible for the management of safe and effective operation of research reactors, development of new research reactors and the fuel for them. He is an active participant of the Russian Program of Reducing Uranium Enrichment in Research Reactors from the beginning of the Program. Later during several years he also worked in the field of decommissioning of research reactors and the final stage of the research reactors fuel cycle including the storage and the transportation of SNF to the reprocessing plant.

He worked for IAEA in the frame of short term contracts and special service agreements and many times was nominated as a consultant of the Agency.

Mr. Arkhangelskiy holds a Ph.D. in Nuclear Engineering from RRC “Kurchatov Institute”. He is a member of the Russian Nuclear Society. He is a laureate of several national and international prizes for the achievements in the field of research reactors.
