I began working on neutron research for the Atomic Energy Commission of Argentina (CNEA) in 1971. In 1983, I was appointed as first Manager of the RA-6 Research Reactor ("Nuclear Research Reactor Manager" licensed by the Argentinean Nuclear Regulatory Authority).

In 1986 I entered INVAP, in charge of different reactor-related activities (I take part in all the reactor design developed and constructed by INVAP, in Argentina, Peru, Algeria, Egypt and Australia).

In 2001 appointed Technological Relation Manager of INVAP. As such I take part in all domestic and international meetings on research reactors, and I usually represent Argentina in the activities carried out by IAEA in this field.

In 2006 appointed Advisor to the President of CNEA on "University Subjects" (Staff member of CNEA).

In November 2006 the High Council of UNCu (in agreement with CNEA), appointed me as Director (Dean) of Instituto Balseiro (Faculty).

Also, I am Professor at the University of "Cuyo" (Nuclear Engineering Career) in the field of Nuclear Power Plants.

Since 1997 I am member of the "Steering Committee" of the International Group on Research Reactors. I have been IAEA "Expert in Research Reactors" on official missions.
