## **INTRODUCTION**

- Angola joint IAEA in November 1999;
- The Atomic Energy Law was approved by National Assembly in 2007 (Law 4/07);
- The Regulatory Body (AREA) was approved by the Council of Minister in 2007 (Decree 79/07);
- The AREA is under Ministry of Energy;
- Actually the Regulations are in drafting (drawing) process.

## **Uranium in Angola**

All mining are under control of the Ministry of Geology and Mine.

The previous (more than 30 years ago) study of Angola's soil proved that we have Uranium.

There is no Uranium activity in Angola.

During a practical exercise at Faculty of Science, using gamma spectrometry equipment the students found out that the abundance (percentage) of U-235 per unit of mass in the Angola's sample was bigger than the sample provided by IAEA.
