Briefing Summary:

High and volatile fossil fuel prices, the need for a base-load electricity supply technology with stable and predictable generating costs, energy security and climate change considerations have led to rising expectations for nuclear power. On a life cycle basis, the greenhouse gas emissions per kWh of nuclear power are comparable with the emissions of the best renewable technologies. The session will review recent global nuclear projections; specific national nuclear energy plans of Poland; IAEA capacity building in developing countries for energy system analysis and climate change mitigation; and the legal, safety, security, non-proliferation and technical assistance the IAEA provides to countries interested in nuclear energy.
