Vienna's English Theatre, founded in 1963, is the oldest English-language theatre in continental Europe and a valued cultural institution in Vienna. Originally a summer theater for English speaking tourists, it won immediate acceptance by the Viennese public and extended its initial season to offer year round programs. After its opening the theater has moved several times to accommodate its growing audience. In 1974, the theater gained the support of the city of Vienna in finding its permanent home in Josefgasse. Julia Safranek, the daughter of the theatre's founders, is now the Artistic Director. She will tell us the colourful history of the theater.
