We then continue on to the picturesque village of Dürnstein, probably best known for the remain of the former fortress where King Richard, the Lion-Heart first stop off for lunch at the Kosterkeller (at extra individual expense) and then enjoy a walking tour past houses dating from the 13th-14th century and enjoy a guided tour of the historic church and former abbey towering above the Danube. We will conclude with a special wine tasting to enjoy the products of the surrounding vineyards. We will also have time to explore the inviting small shops in Dürnstein before the bus brings us back to Operngasse 4 by 7 p.m.
