**Payment Conditions:**

A deposit of three nights is requested to confirm your registration. Payment can be made either by Credit Card or by Bank transfer. The final hotel bill has to be settled directly with the hotel either in cash or with credit card.

**Transport from airport to the Hotel:**

Bus transportation to and from the New Dolmen Hotel will be organized both ways at the cost of LM6 (Maltese Lira). The monetary unit of Malta is the Maltese Lira (LM) which is in denominations of LM20,LM10,LM5 and LM2. Coins are in denominations of LM1,50c,25c,10c, 5c and 1c.
