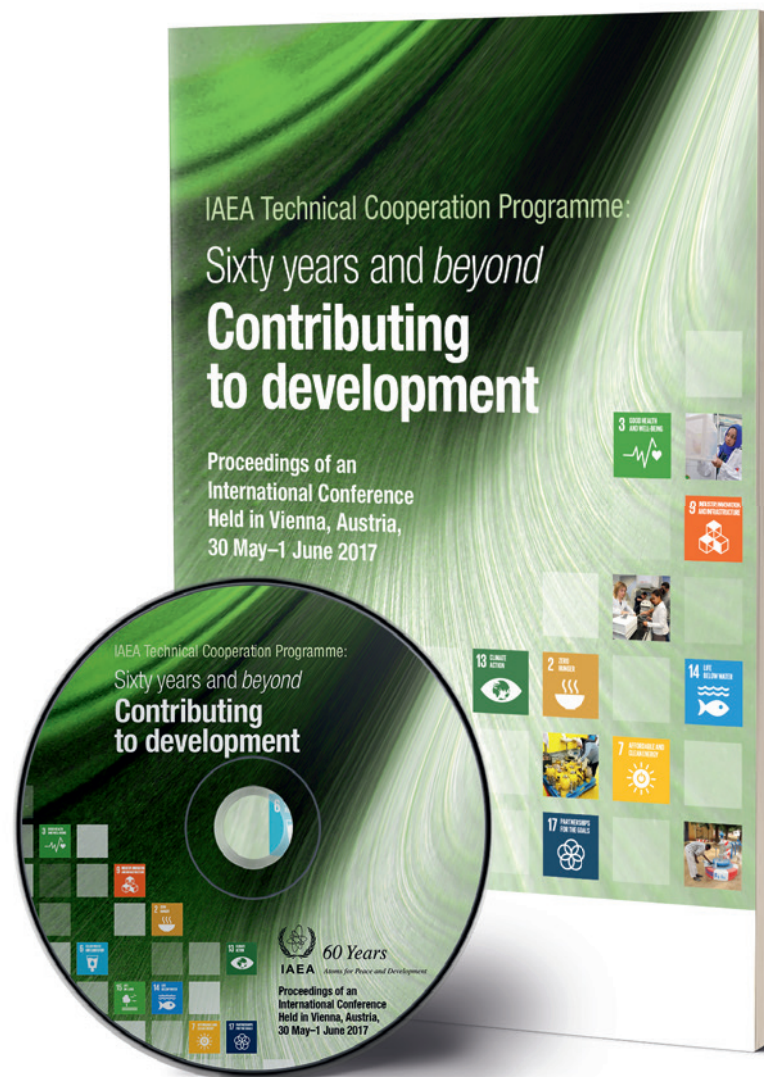

Presenting the proceedings of the International Conference on the IAEA Technical Cooperation Programme: Sixty Years and Beyond – Contributing to Development, this publication includes highlights of the conference sessions as well as the conference’s Concluding Remarks. The proceedings detail how the TC programme has contributed to the establishment of national nuclear infrastructure and capabilities in Member States over six decades, in support of their national development priorities.
