Akira Omoto is a nuclear engineer specializing in risk management and nuclear energy policy and is currently a project professor at the Tokyo Institute of Technology. Mr. Omoto is the former Director of the Division of Nuclear Power of the IAEA.

He was previously a commissioner of United States Atomic Energy Commission and an advisor to the Nuclear Risk Research Center of the Central Research Institute of Electric Power Industry. He started his professional career by working at TEPCO.

He has recently been engaged in a joint study by Japanese institutions with MIT in the field of integration of nuclear and intermittent renewables.

His academic background includes a PhD in Engineering from the Department of Nuclear Engineering of the University of Tokyo and a Masters degree from the same University.
