

Oksana Tarasova

Chief, Atmospheric Environment Research Division, World Meteorological Organization, Switzerland

Dr. Oksana Tarasova has been the Chief of the Global Atmosphere Watch (GAW) Programme of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) since 2014. The programme provides an international framework for global observations and analysis of the atmospheric chemical composition changes in support of environmental conventions and services.

From 2009 to 2014 she worked as a scientific officer within GAW with the major focus on greenhouse gases and traditional air pollutants.

Before joining the World Meteorological Organization, she worked at Max-Planck Institute for Chemistry in Mainz and in the Lomonosov Moscow State University, where she graduated with honours in 1996.

She has also co-chaired the Task Force for Measurements and Modelling in the Convention on Long-Range Transboundary Air Pollution since 2010. From 2011 to 2015 she served as the President of Atmospheric Sciences Division of the European Geoscience Union.

Dr Tarasova is a member of the International Commission on Atmospheric Chemistry and Global Pollution (ICACGP) since 2015.
