Seville D. David Jr. is Executive Director of the National Water Resources Board (NWRB) of the Philippines. He supervises the NWRB's various activities as the agency mandated by the Government to administer and manage the country's water resources. This includes regulation of water resources and utilities, policy and planning supported by research and development of water resources, including the application of advanced technologies, such as isotope studies.

David completed his B.Sc. degree in Geology at the University of the Philippines, Diliman in 1986 and earned his Masters and Doctoral degrees in Earth Science from the University of Nice-Sophia Antipolis in France in 1990 and 1994 respectively. This was followed by a Research Fellowship grant at the Geosciences Azur in Sophia Antipolis, Valbonne, France in 1997. He was also seconded by the Philippine Government as Regional Expert of the Coordinating Committee for Geosciences Programmes in East and Southeast Asia (CCOP), an intergovernmental organization based in Bangkok, Thailand from 2000 to 2004. David has been involved in the geologic hazards assessment and groundwater resources assessment programmes which were priority government programmes on disaster risk management and climate change adaptation
