



## Mr Ricardo Uauy

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Ricardo Uauy is currently a Professor of Public Health Nutrition at the University of Chile and London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine in the United Kingdom. He received his Doctorate of Medicine from the University of Chile in 1972 and his PhD in Nutritional Biochemistry from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in 1977. He trained at the Pediatrics Harvard Children's Hospital in Boston and the Neonatology Yale New-Haven Hospital, and is Board-certified in Pediatrics and Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine (USA). Uauy first became an Associate Professor at the Institute of Nutrition (INTA) at the University of Chile in 1977 and a Professor in 1981. He was Director of INTA from 1994 to 2002, and President of the International Union of Nutrition Sciences from 2005 to 2009. He has served as an expert on multiple WHO/FAO committees, and has received several awards, including the McCollum Lecture award ASN (USA) in 2000, the National Applied Science Award from the Government of Chile in 2012, and the Doctor Honoris Causa by the University of Granada in 2014. He has written more than 350 scientific journal publications and has edited 10 books.



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
