Shaukat Abdulrazak is the Director for the Division for Africa at the IAEA Department of Technical Cooperation. In this capacity, he facilitates IAEA technical cooperation support to 45 countries in Africa. Before joining the IAEA, Abdulrazak worked as CEO at the Kenya National Commission for Science, Technology and Innovation. He has more than 20 years working experience as a professor and university administrator, chairman and member of national and international boards, including the African Technology Policy Studies, the Kenya National Economic Social Council, the African Commission on Nuclear Energy and the International Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology.

Abdulrazak is a Fellow of The World Academy of Sciences, the African Academy of Sciences, the Japan Society for the Promotion of Sciences. He has published over 120 papers in international journals, scientific conference and symposia proceedings. He has been an editorial board member and reviewer of several international refereed journals. His undergraduate studies were at Egerton University, Kenya. Abdulrazak obtained his Master of Science and PhD degrees from the University of Aberdeen, United Kingdom, and his Post Doctorate from the Shimane University, Japan.
