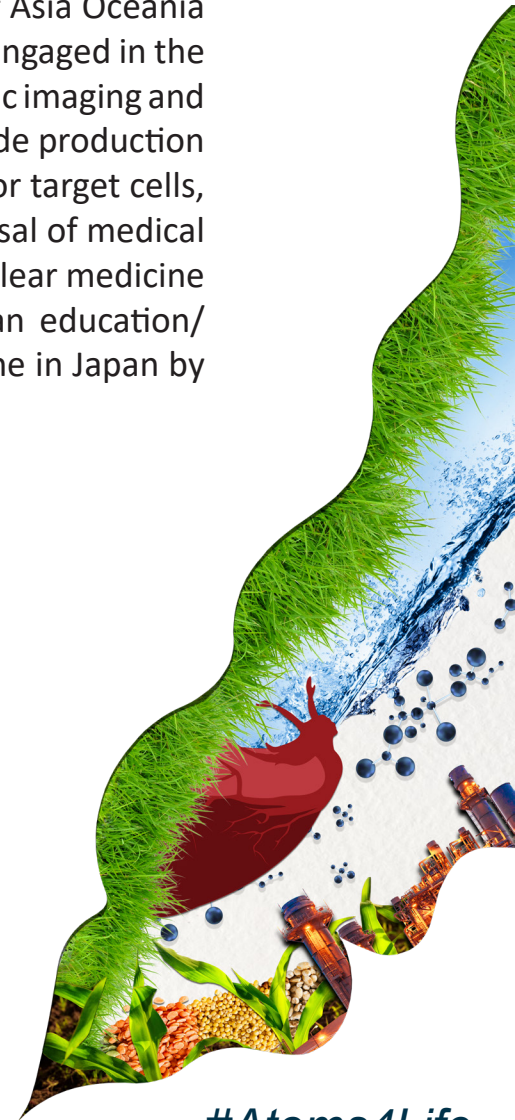




Mr Jun Hatazawa

Professor and Chairman, Osaka University Graduate School of Medicine, Japan

Jun Hatazawa is Professor and Chair of Nuclear Medicine and Tracer Kinetics at Osaka University Graduate School of Medicine and is appointed President of Asia Oceania Federation of Nuclear Medicine and Biology from 2017 to 2020. He is engaged in the “Atoms for Medicine” project where nuclear energy is used for diagnostic imaging and targeted radionuclide therapy of cancer. This project covers radionuclide production with accelerator, purification of radionuclide, labelling biomolecules for target cells, dosimetry and safety, nuclear medicine education/practice, and disposal of medical radioactive waste. He is promoting this project in the Asia Oceania nuclear medicine community and beyond. Hatazawa is also involved in establishing an education/training platform for human resource development in nuclear medicine in Japan by collaborating with the IAEA.
