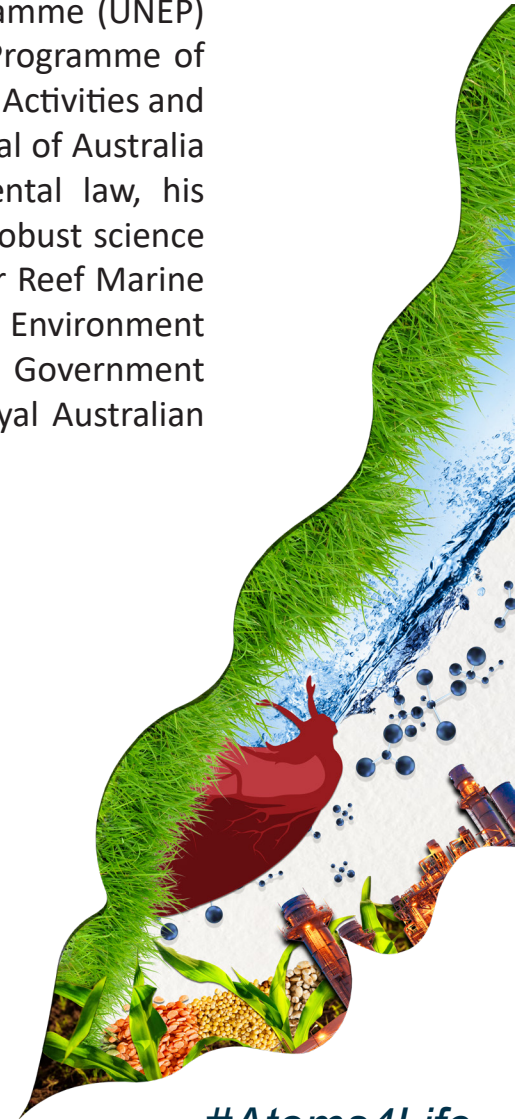




Mr David Osborn

David Osborn joined the IAEA as Director, Environment Laboratories, in Monaco in January 2013. Formerly with the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) in Nairobi and The Hague, he was Coordinator of the 1995 Global Programme of Action for the Protection of the Marine Environment from Land-Based Activities and Coordinator of UNEP's Ecosystem Management Programme. A national of Australia with qualifications in both environmental science and environmental law, his interests and career have focussed extensively on the link between robust science and good governance. He has held director posts at the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority and the Australian Government's Department of the Environment and Water Resources and has served as an Advisor to the Australian Government Minister for the Environment. He was formerly an officer in the Royal Australian Navy.
