The second Russia–IAEA Nuclear Energy Management School for Managers in Nuclear Organizations is organized in the Russian Federation by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) in cooperation with State Atomic Energy Corporation “Rosatom” through Rosatom Technical Academy (Rosatom Tech). This one-week event is devoted to building leadership competencies essential to supporting nuclear infrastructure development in countries embarking on or expanding national nuclear power programmes. The School is aimed at providing mid-level managers in the nuclear sector and governments of IAEA Member States with broad understanding of key issues and challenges associated with peaceful use of nuclear technology.

Topics covered by the School include:

- ✧ International cooperation and IAEA support;
- ✧ Leadership and management in a nuclear enterprise;
- ✧ An integrated approach to people management;
- ✧ Energy planning, production, distribution and markets;
- ✧ Legal aspects, nuclear law;
- ✧ Nuclear safety, nuclear security, nuclear safeguards; and
- ✧ Stakeholder involvement and communication.

Each topic is approached both in the form of lectures delivered by IAEA and other experts, and in panel discussions involving all
