Dr Bellin is currently President of the Board of France's Radioprotection and Nuclear Safety Institute (IRSN). As a technical safety organization, IRSN carries out scientific partnerships and provides services through agreements with international organizations.

She is also a Professor of Radiology at University Paris-Sud, France, and is involved in research and education. Her areas of expertise are abdominal imaging and contrast media, and scientific contributions in this field have included 112 articles in peer-reviewed scientific journals and 75 lectures, as well as authoring four textbooks. As Chairperson of the Radiology Department at University Hospital Bicêtre-Paul Brousse, her current clinical practices include diagnostic radiology and participation in multidisciplinary meetings with oncologists, urologists, and gastrointestinal surgeons. She is also involved in strategic decisions regarding the future of imaging in the hospital and serves as Chair of the European Society of Uro-Radiology.
