Mary Gospodarowicz is a Professor of Radiation Oncology at the University of Toronto, Medical Director of the Princess Margaret Cancer Centre at the University Health Network, Regional Vice President of Cancer Care Ontario, and Immediate Past-President of the Union for International Cancer Control (UICC). Ms. Gospodarowicz has expertise in internal medicine, radiation oncology and medical oncology. Her research focuses on evaluating radiation therapy, image-guided precision radiotherapy and cancer survivorship. Her current interests include global cancer control and access

to radiotherapy and quality cancer care. She participated in the Global Task Force on Expanded Access to Cancer Care and Control as part of the Harvard Global Equity Initiative, the Lancet Commission on Global Access to Pain Control and Palliative Care, and the UICC's Global Task Force on Radiotherapy for Cancer Control. Ms Gospodarowicz is also an associate editor of the Journal of Global Oncology.
