Let me congratulate you on your election as the President of the 64th General Conference.

Bangladesh deeply appreciates IAEA's serious commitment to its mandate. It is highly commendable that even during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Agency has continued its valuable work under the able leadership of the new Director General, despite many difficulties.

We acknowledge with thanks the assistance rendered by the Agency to Bangladesh and many other Member States in their efforts to address the current COVID-19 pandemic through the technical cooperation project INT0098. Bangladesh is firmly committed to the peaceful uses of nuclear energy in compliance with the relevant safety, safeguard and security measures.

We commend the Agency and the Member States for organizing the third International Conference on Nuclear Security 2020 and adopting Ministerial Declaration. At the same time, we are expecting a substantial progress at the next NPT Review Conference.

Lastly, Bangladesh reiterates its firm support to the mandate and activities of the Agency for a better world through peaceful uses of nuclear technology.
