GOA-ON holds virtual OA Week conference

From the 8 to 10 September 2020, GOA-ON, with support from the OA-ICC, led a virtual OA conference with ten sessions, 50 speakers, and hundreds of participants from around the world. Others participated online via GOA-ON website and social media, and by accessing the OA-ICC news stream, which saw greatly increased traffic around the conference dates. Each of the GOA-ON Hubs, including the newly formed Arctic Hub, presented updates. One session was led by organizations that work closely with the OA-ICC, such as The Ocean Foundation (TOF), the Global Ocean Observation System (GOOS), Marine Biodiversity Observing Network (MBON) and the International Alliance to Combat Ocean Acidification. The meeting took place on the initial dates of the now postponed 5th International Symposium on the Ocean in a High CO₂ World, and emphasized the need to address research questions that will allow humanity to adapt and respond to ocean chemistry changes. OA Week demonstrates continued resilience and adaptability of the OA research community, as well as the potential of the virtual format as a tool for strengthening OA collaboration during and after the COVID-19 global pandemic. New dates for the 5th International Symposium on the Ocean in a High-CO2 World Announced

The 5th International Symposium on the Ocean in a High CO₂ World has officially been rescheduled for 13 to 16 September 2021. The deadline for abstract submissions and travel grant applications has now been extended to 15 March 2021. Conference organisers will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation in Peru in case further scheduling adjustments will need to be made. The OA-ICC will again cooperate in this event and will maintain its previous commitments.

OA-ICC Supporting global OA science during the COVID 19 Pandemic

During 2020, the OA-ICC continued to support the UN Communities of

<u>Ocean Action (COA) on ocean acidification (SDG 14.3)</u>. To date, more than 265 COA Voluntary Commitments (VC) have been submitted and assessed in a recent report. Progress in this COA OA effort is continued through a series of webinars with VC holders and the OA community. The OA community had organized a series of events to advance global OA efforts, though many of these planned events had to be postponed due to the COVID 19 pandemic. Nevertheless, the global OA community was able to rally around several important virtual events this year such as the <u>Ocean Dialogues</u>, <u>Climate Week in NYC</u>, and the <u>UN High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development</u>. These virtual events give us hope that even in a year as challenging as 2020, the strong will and dedication of the global OA community can make significant contributions towards the SDG 14.3 and the UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development process.
