First International Conference on Nuclear Law the Global Debate



25-29 April 2022
Vienna, Austria

The IAEA's **First International Conference on Nuclear Law** will provide a unique global forum to discuss current topical issues of the four primary branches of international and national nuclear law - nuclear safety, security, safeguards and civil liability for nuclear damage - as well as the interaction of nuclear law with other areas of national and international law.

The IAEA plays a multi-faceted role in the development and implementation of nuclear law. Through its Legislative Assistance Programme, the IAEA also assists, upon request, countries in adhering to and effectively implementing the relevant international instruments.

Target Audience

The Conference is aimed at and will be of interest to 1) representatives from governments, including policymakers, lawmakers and regulators; 2) international organizations; 3) non-governmental organizations; 4) nuclear industry; 5) legal and insurance sectors; and 6) academia and civil society. The IAEA welcomes and encourages the participation of women, early career professionals, and individuals from developing countries.

Participation and Registration

No registration fee is charged to participants. All persons wishing to participate in the Conference must be designated by an IAEA Member State or should be a member of an invited organization. Engagement of Students and Early Career Professionals

Students and early career professionals up to 35 years of age were invited to submit innovative and original essays on the topic "Nuclear Law: Today and Tomorrow". Finalists in the essay competition will present their essays at The Legal Brief, a TED-like side event at the Conference.

Finalists will receive cash prizes, a certificate signed by the IAEA Director General and financial support toward participation. The essays will be posted on the Conference website and included in the Conference proceedings.

In addition, the Conference will provide the setting for a Dedicated Youth Segment, developed to engage students and young professionals in a discussion on a current nuclear law topic.
