- Access to the VIC:** Please be aware that due to construction work on the U1 line, the stop “Kaisermühlen/VIC” will be closed in the direction of Oberlaa from 8 August until end of November 2022. This means trains will not stop at the VIC. As an alternative, passengers can travel one stop further to “Donau Insel” and then take the train back one stop to “Kaisermühlen/VIC”.
