All statements received will be made available on the IAEA conference website (see below) in PDF format, unless the distribution is restricted by the delegation. In such a case, this should be clearly marked on the statement. Hard copies of the statements made in the sessions will not be distributed.

## **Speaking Order**

A ballot was held on Tuesday, 6 September at the IAEA Secretariat to determine the order in which speakers will deliver their national statements during the conference. Ministers and Heads of Delegation will speak in the order determined by the speakers' ballot following the practice of giving priority to Ministers.

## **Visas**

Participants representing foreign governments who are traveling for bilateral purpose as well as IAEA activities require an A-1 or A-2 type visas to attend the ministerial. Participants traveling on behalf of a foreign government for IAEA activities require a G-1, G-2, or G-3 visa and representatives traveling on behalf of designated international organizations require a G-4 visa to attend. Participants from the private sector or non-governmental organizations who are not U.S. citizens must apply for a Nonimmigrant B-1 Business Visa or Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA). Please review the latest visa regulations on the U.S. Embassy/Consulate Website for your country of residence. You will find all official U.S. Embassies and Consulates on this [website](#). Approval of your visa may require additional administrative processing, which adds additional time to normal processing from the time you submit an application. In order to meet the proposed arrival date, it is recommended you apply for your visa as-soon-as-possible, at least several weeks in advance of your travel and earlier if possible. Please note that the wait times for B visas remains long as a result of the pandemic. If you apply and receive a visa appointment date beyond that of the event, you can request an expedited appointment using the U.S. Embassy website where you applied.

### **Accommodation**

Participants are expected to make their own travel and hotel arrangements. Please note that the IAEA cannot assist you with hotel bookings and cannot be held responsible for any cancellation fees or re-bookings.

### **Transportation**

From Washington Dulles International (IAD) Airport to hotels and Washington Convention Center is approx. 28-30 miles.

From Baltimore Washington International (BWI) Airport to hotels and Washington Convention Center is approx. 38-40 miles.

From Reagan Washington National (DCA) Airport to hotels and Washington Convention Center is approx. 5 miles.
