Anyone wishing to present at the conference must submit an abstract in electronic format using the conference's file submission system (<u>IAEA-INDICO</u>), which is accessible from the conference web page (<u>https://www.iaea.org/events/icwedr2023</u>). The abstract can be submitted through this system until **02 June 2023**.

Conference registration is done through the InTouch+ platform (<u>https://intouchplus.iaea.org</u>).

Grants/funding

All young professionals are encouraged to participate in the conference and the IAEA is also offering grants to support participation. The conference committee will allocate funds to support a maximum of 10 grants as a contribution to partially cover travel and accommodation expenses for selected young professionals. The award will be decided by the committee based on the quality of the submitted abstract.

Eligibility for grant

Candidates must be under the age of 35. Candidates can be either bachelors, masters or doctoral students, postdoctoral fellows, or young professionals working in the industries targeted by the conference.

Interested candidates are required to submit abstracts for papers/posters or brief research proposals on any of the conference themes, and then submit their award application via the <u>IAEA-INDICO</u> system. In addition, there is an option for candidates to submit a short video (up to 5 minutes in duration) introducing themselves and their topic. The videos should be submitted by 30 July 2023. Guidelines will be posted on the INDICO site.
