The International Conference on Research Reactors: Achievements, Experience and the Way to a Sustainable Future (ICRR2023) will be held at King Hussein Bin Talal Convention Centre, Dead Sea, Jordan managed by the Hilton Dead Sea Resort & Spa. The Conference will be organized by the IAEA and hosted by the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan through the Jordan Atomic Energy Commission (JAEC).

Conference Venue

The conference will be held at the King Hussein Bin Talal Convention Centre, Dead Sea, Jordan.

The King Hussein Bin Talal Convention Centre (KHBTC), situated on the eastern shores of the Dead Sea in Jordan, has been selected as the venue for this conference. This world-class convention center, managed by Hilton, is located at the lowest point on earth (about 400 meters below sea level). Established in 2005, the KHBTC gained prominence as it hosted the World Economic Forum in Jordan for the first time and the Arab Summit in 2018. With its impressive three-story structure, the center offers a spacious setting capable of accommodating over 4,000 guests. It boasts 27 conference halls, lounges, foyers, and several outdoor terraces, providing ample space for various activities. Conveniently, the KHBTC is situated 65 kilometers away from Queen Alia International Airport and 45 kilometers from Amman.

Visa Information

In order to make the appropriate visa arrangements for your participation in the event, please contact the diplomatic or consular representative at the embassies of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan in your country or the nearest to your country at least 8 weeks before you travel to Jordan.

A passport with a validity of at least 6 months and a visa are required for entry into Jordan.

Many nationalities do not require prior approval to enter Jordan and can obtain a visa immediately upon the completion of the application and payment of visa fees at Amman's Queen Alia International Airport.

It is encouraged to apply at least 8 weeks so as to expedite the process of obtaining the required visa.

In general, the visa issuance arrangements are your own responsibility, nevertheless, the Jordanian authorities will provide you with the necessary assistance in this regard.
