VIC badges for General Conference delegates: Entrance to the Scientific Forum is open to all participants holding a yellow, full red, grey or blue (staff) badge. Participants holding these badges **do not need an additional badge for participation in the Scientific Forum**. Members of official delegations of Member States attending the General Conference and holding red badges can enter the VIC without security screening.

All other participants who do not hold an access badge to the General Conference or the VIC will need to collect their participant badge from the VIC Pass Office following the instructions below. Please bring with you an identification document with picture to facilitate your entry to the meeting premises and to facilitate the registration process.
