Marisa Fazzino is a medical oncologist who graduated at the University of Republic (UDELAR) in Montevideo, Uruguay in 1994 and completed a scholarship at the National Cancer Institute of Milan.

Since 2020 she is Director of the National Cancer Control Program, Ministry of Health, Uruguay and Director of the Oncology Division at the “Hospital Policial”, Montevideo.

She was medical oncologist at the Honorary Commission to Fight Against Cancer in the Areas of Cervical cancer Prevention, Education to the population and Training to the health team, between 2006 and 2012.

She was President of the Uruguayan Medical and Pediatric Oncology Society (SOMPU) between 2009 and 2011 and President of the Uruguayan Committee of CME in Oncology (SOMPU) between 2013 and 2019.

She was Secretary of the Uruguayan Society of Mastology (SUM): 1994-1996.

She was in the Board of Directors of the Latinoamerican Federation of Mastology, representing Uruguay (FLAM) between 1995 and 1998.

Coordinated the ImPACT Review in Uruguay and participated in several activities developed by the International Agency of Cancer Research (IARC) and PAHO.
