With more than 15 years' experience, she spent many years supporting refugees through a UNHCR sponsored NGO and has also provided consultancy services to the Kaolack Regional Hospital.

In her role as head of the Office against Cancer, Ms Dieng is responsible for coordinating and supervising all activities in the fight against cancer in her country. She also coordinated the evaluation of the cancer plan between 2015-2019 (with IAEA support) and has been working on a new plan for 2024-2028 which will be launched to coincide with World Cancer Day. Ms Dieng is the IAEA focal point within the Senegalese Ministry of Health and Social Action.
