International Program Director, Office of Radiological Security, U.S. National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA)



Ms Kristina Hatcher serves as the Director for the International Program in the United States Department of Energy/National Nuclear Security Administration's Office of Radiological Security (ORS) where she oversees ORS' partnership with over 80 countries.

Before becoming Director she served a year as the Alternative Technology Coordinator under the Waste Technology Section of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA). Her role at the IAEA was to develop a new programme to increase awareness of alternatives to high activity radioactive sources.

Prior to working at the IAEA, Kristina was the United States Country Officer in ORS where she oversaw the implementation of security enhancements at more than 700 nuclear and radiological sites including sites in New York, Philadelphia, Boston, and Washington, D.C.

Kristina also helped establish ORS's Reduce pillar which focuses on permanent risk reduction through the adoption of Alternative Technologies. Kristina joined NNSA through the Nonproliferation Graduate Fellowship Program in the Global Threat Reduction Initiative. She received her graduate degree from the University of Denver in International Security.
