HE Mr Ambassador Götz Schmidt-Bremme studied law and philosophy in Bonn and Lausanne, followed by practical legal training in Düsseldorf. Joining the Foreign Service in 1990, he served in various capacities, including Deputy Consul-General in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, and then as Head of the Economic Section at the German Embassy in Lisbon.

His roles extended to Deputy Head of International Criminal Law and Tax Law Division, Deputy Consul-General in São Paulo, and Head of the Division for Private International Law. In 2012, he became Minister (economic affairs) in Paris, and then Director for Legal and Consular Issues including Migration.

Since 2017, Ambassador Schmidt-Bremme has served as the Ambassador for the 2017-2018 GFMD Co-Chairmanship and as the Ambassador to the Kingdom of Morocco from 2017 to 2021. In August 2021, he assumed the position of Permanent Representative to the UN and other International Organizations in Vienna.
