

Mr Amine Habouchi, Head of Radiology Department at CHU Bab El Oued, Anchor Centre, Algeria

Professor Habouchi is a medical doctor, interventional radiologist and professor at the Faculty of Medicine of Algiers, University of Algiers 3, where he has been teaching since January 2012. Currently serving as the Acting Head of the Medical Imaging Department at the University Hospital of Bab El Oued, he brings extensive expertise in diagnostic and interventional radiology.

He holds a Master of Science (2016) and multiple interuniversity diplomas and fellowships. Professor Habouchi has held several key leadership roles, including Head of the Vascular Radiology Diagnostic and Interventional Unit (2014-2020) at the University Hospital of Bab El Oued.
