RULES REGARDING THE ACCEPTANCE OF
VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND

Report of the Administrative and Legal Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Furio ZAMPETTI (Italy)

1. The Committee, at its twelfth meeting on 29 September 1958, considered item 16 of the agenda, concerning rules regarding the acceptance of voluntary contributions to the General Fund. The Committee had before it a draft resolution [GC(II)/37] submitted by the Board of Governors. The Committee unanimously approved the draft resolution.

2. The Committee accordingly recommends that the General Conference adopt the following resolutions:

RULES REGARDING THE ACCEPTANCE OF VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE AGENCY
The General Conference,

(a) Recalling paragraph 4 of its resolution of 22 October 1957 in which it requested the Board of Governors to submit recommendations concerning rules to govern the acceptance of voluntary contributions by the Agency, and

(b) Noting that the Board has so far been unable to comply with that request;

1. Requests the Board of Governors to prepare rules regarding the acceptance of voluntary contributions to the Agency as soon as possible, and to submit them to the General Conference for approval at its third regular session; and

2. Authorizes the Board, as a provisional measure and without constituting a precedent, to apply those rules to the acceptance of such voluntary contributions as may be made to the Agency before the General Conference has approved the rules.
