ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS

Memorandum by the Director General

- 1. Under Rule 86 of the Rules of Procedure the General Committee is called upon to determine the number of elective places which must be filled on the Board of Governors so as to ensure that, after the end of the session, the Board will include ten Members elected by the General Conference. The Committee is further required to specify each geographical area in respect of which an election is required so as to ensure that the Board will include a Member elected by the General Conference from each geographical area, except North America, specified in Rule 83.
- 2. On 3 October 1957 the General Conference elected to the Board the seven Members shown for the geographical areas listed below: $\frac{1}{2}$

Latin America

Western Europe

Italy

Eastern Europe

Romania

Africa and the Middle East

South Asia

Pakistan

South East Asia and the

Pacific

The Far East

Korea

In addition Guatemala, Peru and Turkey were elected to bring the number of Members elected by the General Conference up to the statutory number of ten²/.

Egypt, Guatemala, Indonesia, Italy and Peru were elected to the Board for a term of one year, which term will expire at the end of the second regular session of the General Conference.

3. The Director General accordingly suggests that the General Committee will wish to report to the General Conference that, during its second regular session, five Members must be elected to the Board of Governors in order to comply with the provisions of Rule 83 of the Rules of Procedure; and that in these elections a Nember must be elected in respect of each of the following geographical areas

Vestern Lurope

Africa and the Middle East

South East Asia and the Pacific.

4. For the convenience of the Committee, a draft of a report to the General Conference in this sense is annexed hereto. With regard to paragraph 3 thereof, the Director General is aware that the Rules of Procedure do not specifically require the Ceneral Committee to draw the attention of the General Conference to the information it contains. The Committee may none the less wish to include a paragraph on these lines in its report by reason of its general mandate, under Rule 42(b), to assist in conducting the work of the General Conference.

ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS

Report by the General Committee

- 1. Rule 86 of the Rules of Procedure stipulates that the General Committee shall determine the number of elective places to be filled on the Board of Governors in order to ensure that, after the end of the session, the Board shall include ten Members elected by the General Conference. The General Committee accordingly notifies the General Conference that it has determined that five Members must be elected to the Board of Governors at its second regular session in order to satisfy the requirements of Rule 83.
- 2. Under Rule 86, the General Committee is also called upon to specify each geographical area in respect of which an election is required to ensure that, after the end of the session, the Board shall include a Member elected by the General Conference from each geographical area, except North America, specified in Rule 83. In compliance with this provision of the Rules of Procedure, the General Committee hereby specifies that elections are required in respect of the following geographical areas.
 - (a) Testern Europe,
 - (b) Africa and the Middle East; and
 - (c) South East Asia and the Pacific.
- 3. In view of the requirement in Rule 83 that the General Conference shall conduct elections with due regard to equitable representation on the Board as a whole of the Members in the geographical areas specified in that Rule, the General Committee suggests that the following list of Members which have so far been designated by the Board $\frac{1}{2}$ or elected by the General Conference to serve on the Board after the end of the second regular session of the General
