## EIECTION OF WEMBPS TO THE BOARD OF GOVBRNORS

## Memorandum by the Director General

1. Under Rule 86 of the Rules of Procedure the General Committoc is called upon to determine the number of clective places which must bo fillod on the Board of Governors so as to ensuro that, after the end of tho sossion, the Board will include ten Members clectod by the General Conferenoo. The Committee is further required to specify each geographical aroa in respect of which an election is required so as to ensure that the Board will include a Member elected by the General Confercnce from each geographical arca, except North Americas specified in Rulo 83.
2. On 3 October 1957 the Gonoral Conference chose, in acoordanco with Article VI.D of the Statute, tho following five of the ten Mombors it elected to the Board onthat day to servo for a term of two years:

Argentina The Republic of Koroa
Romania
Pakistan.

This torm will expire at the end of the third regular session of the General Conference.
3. The Director General accordingly suggests that the General Committee will wish to report to the General Conforence that, during its third rogular session, five Members must be eloctod to the Board of Governors in order to

BIECTION OF MBRPRS TO THE BOARD OF GOURPHORS
Report by tho General Committee

1. Pule 86 of the Rules of Procodure stipulates that the Gonoral Committee shall determine the number of cloctivo places to be filled on the Board of Governors in order to ensure that, after the end of the session, the Board shall include ten Members elocted by the Gencral Conferenco. The Genoral Committeo accordingly notifies tho Gcneral Conference that it has determinod that five Members must bo electod to the Board at its third rogular session in order to satisfy the requiremonts of Rulo 83.
2. Under Rule 86 , the General Committec is also called upon to spocify oach geographical area in respect of which an cloction is required to onsure that, after the end of the session, the Board shall incluade a Mombor oloctod by tho Gencral Conference from cach coographical area, except North America, specified in fule 83. In compliance with this provision of the Irules of Procedure, the Goneral Committoo horoby specifios that olections are requirod in rospoct of the following geographical arcas:
(a) Eastern Europe;
(b) South Asiag and
(c) The Far East.
3. In viow of the requiremonts in Rulo 83 that the Gonoral Conforonco shall conduct olections with due rogard to oquitablo represontation on the Board as a whole of the Members in the roographical areas spocificd in that Rule, the Gencral Committee suggests that tho following list of Membors that have so far
