ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS FOR INITIAL DISCUSSION

Proposal by Poland for an additional item

In the light of Rule 15 of the Rules of Procedure, the Director General is communicating to the General Committee the texts of a letter and its enclosure which he received from the Polish delegation on 19 September 1960.

"The Polish delegation proposes, under Rule 15 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference, the inclusion in the agenda of the General Conference at its fourth regular session of the matter of the grant of consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions.

"The explanatory memorandum required under Rule 20 of the Rules of Procedure is attached hereto."

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. The Polish delegation is proposing the inclusion in the agenda of the General Conference of the matter of the grant of consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions.
2. The Polish delegation is of the view that the matter is important and urgent. This is brought out, inter alia, by the fact that the General Conference at its third regular session adopted a resolution recommending the Board of Governors, in accordance with Article V.D. of the Statute, to reconsider the question of granting consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions,^{1/} and by the contents of the report by the Board of Governors in document GC(IV)/INF/29.
