Resolution adopted during the 43rd plenary meeting on 29 September 1960

PROVISION OF EQUIPMENT IN TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROJECTS

The General Conference,

- (a) <u>Considering</u> the special character of the Agency's operations and the increasing demand for equipment in the less-developed countries,
- (b) Considering further paragraph 5 of the Annex to the report by the Board of Governors, $\frac{1}{2}$ and the explanation given in footnote $\sqrt{5}$ thereto, and
- (c) <u>Recognizing</u> that the total of technical assistance put at the disposal of any given State may comprise fellowships, experts and equipment,

Requests the Board of Governors to give special and sympathetic attention to providing, in the framework of technical assistance projects, equipment to those States which desire it.
