Resolution adopted during the 62nd plenary meeting on 6 October 1961

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR THEORETICAL PHYSICS

The General Conference,

(a) Recalling its resolution GC(IV)/RES/76 concerning the establishment of an international center for theoretical physics, and

(b) Noting:

- (i) The statement by the Director General on the action so far taken in this matter^{1/};
- (ii) The generous offer by the Government of Italy to help finance and support the establishment of such a center^{2/}; and
- (iii) The interest expressed by other Governments in acting as hosts,

1. Requests the Director General to circulate to Member States a report on the results of the studies so far undertaken;

2. Invites Member States to inform the Director General of the support and facilities they would be prepared to offer for such a center; and

3. Requests the Board of Governors and the Director General:

- (a) To continue studying the matter including the possibilities of receiving from other Governments and institutions offers of support in the form of financial contributions and the provision of facilities; and
- (b) To submit their conclusions to the General Conference at its sixth regular session.
