Decides further that any State that becomes a Member of the Agency during the remainder of 1961 or in 1962 shall be assessed as appropriate for contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for those years, and for its advance to the Working Capital Fund, by applying to its United Nations percentage the same coefficient as was applied in the case of Member States whose rates of assessment are included in the scales of assessment for 1961 and 1962.
