## Memorandum by the Director General

1. Under Rule. 86 of the Rules of Procedure the General Committee is called upon both to determine the number of elective places which must be filled on the Board of Governors by the General Conference and to speaify each geographical area in respect of which an election is required, so as to ensure compliance with the provisions of Article VI.A. 3 of the Statute. In accordance with the present texts of that Article and Rule, the Board must include ten Members so elected.
2. Of the present ten Members elected at previous sessions, the terms of office of the following will expire at the end of the sixth regular session:

The Committee will, therefore, no doubt wish to determine and so report to the General Conference that five Members mast be elected to the Board during its sixth regular session, provided that the present text of Article VI.A. 3 of the statute remains unchanged.
3. The other elected Members are at present:

There will thus remain Mombers elected to the Board by the General Conference in five of the geographical areas specified in fule 83 - Latin America, Western Europe, Eastern Burope, South Asia and the Far East. As a consequenco, the Committeo will doubtless wish, provided that the present text of Articlo VI.A. 3 of the Statuto remains unchanged, to specify that clections must be held for the two areas Africa and the Middle East, and South East Asia and the Pacific in order that the provisions of Rule 86 may bo fully complied with.
4. If, however, the amondmont to Article. VI.A. 3 of the statute which the General Conference appr)ved by Resolution GC(V)/RES/92 should come into force bofore the end of the Board during the sixth regular session, the now Board will have to include 12 Miembers elected by tho General Conforenca 3 . In that event, the Comnittee will doubtless wish to determine, in the light of the information given in paragraph 2 above, and report to the Conference that it must olect sevan Micmbers during the session.
5. The amended text of Article VI.A. 3 of the Statute will provide that the Members of the Board elocted by the Genc.al Conference shall consist of:

3 from Latin Amorica\% I from South Asia;
1 from Western Thepe;
1 from South East Asia and the Pacific;
1 from Eastern Rurope;
3 from Africa and the Middle Bast;

1 from the Far East; and
1 othor Member.
If thereforo that text comes into foreo bofore tho session ends, the Committee will, in tho light of the information given in the first and second sentoncics of paragraph 3 above, presumably wish to specify that two Members must be clected from Latin Anerica, throe from Africa and the Middle East and one from South Bast Asia and the Pacific.
6. For the Committoc's convenionco, a draft of its report to the General Conforence is annexcd hereco. Tho draft follows the toxt of the similar report the Committeo made to tho Genoral Conferenco at its fifth regular scssion $4 /$, oxcopt that it includes the sonso of both paragraphs 2 and 3, as woll as of 4 and 5, abovo as alternatives.

ELICTION OF WHMBERS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS
Report by the Goneral Committoe

1. Rule 86 of the Rules of Procedurc stipulates that the General Committoe shall determine tho number of eloctive placos which must be fillod on tho Board of Governors by tho General Conference so as to ensure compliance with the provisions of Articlo VI.A. 3 of the Statute. The Committoe accordingly notifies the General Conference that on 18 September 1962 it determined that, provided the existing text of that Article remains unchanged, five Members must be elected to tho Board during tho present session. In this connection the Committee invites attention to the last provision in the Article, which stipulates that
"... no member in this category [of mombers electod to tho Board
by the General Conference/ in any one term of office will be
eligible for re-clection in the same category for the following
term of office." I/
2. Rule 86 further providos that the General Committeo shall specify each geographical area in respect of which an cloction is required to onsure that, after the end of the session, tho Board shall include a Member elected by the Gencral Conference from each geographical area, except North Amcrica, specified in Rule 83. In compliance with this provision, the Committee hereby specifies that, if Article VI.A. 3 of the Statute romains unchanged, clections are required in respect of two geographical areas:
(a) Africa and the Middlo East, and
(b) South East Asia and the Pacific.

The other three Mombers may be elected from any geographical area in so far as their election is not precluded by the provisions of Article VI.
3. The Committee also determined, however, that if the amendment to Article VI.A. 3 which the General Conference approved by Resolution $\operatorname{GC}(V) / R E S / 92$ has come into force before the end of the present session, then seven Members must be oloctod during it. The Committec horeby specifies that in these circumstances elections will be roquired in respoct of three geographical areas, as follows:
(a) Two Members from Latin America;
(b) Three Members from Africa and the Middle Easty and
(c) One Member from South East Asia and the Pacific.

The remaining Member may bo elected from any geographical aroa in so far as its election is not procluded by the provisions of Article VI of the Statute.
4. The Committeo has requested its Chairman, in his capacity as President of the Gencral Conference, to inform the Conference immediately before it procecds to elect Mombers to the Board whethor the situation reflcoted in paragraphs 1 and 2 or in paragraph 3 above then obtains.
5. In view of the requirement in Rule 83 that the Gencral Conference shall conduct the elections with due regard to equitable represcntation on the Board as a whole of the Members in the geographical areas spocified in that Rulc, it may wish to have before it the following list of Mernbers that have already been designated by the Board $2^{2 /}$ or elected by the General Conforence $3^{3 /}$ to serve on the Board aftor the end of the present session:
