AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE XIV OF THE STATUTE

Resolution adopted during the 71st plenary meeting on 26 September 1962

THE FINANCING OF THE AGENCY'S ACTIVITIES

The General Conference,

- (a) Noting the records of the exchange of views in the Board of Governors on the proposal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland that Article XIV of the Statute should be amended in such a manner that all the Agency's activities would be financed from a single assessed budget,
- (b) Recalling that in Resolution GC(V)/RES/100 the General Conference expressed the hope of raising voluntary contributions to the General Fund each year more nearly to the level of the agreed target than had hitherto been achieved,
- (c) Recognizing the complexity of the financial problem and the need for further study, and
- (d) Seeking to secure broad support for any proposed changes,

Requests the Board of Governors:

- (a) To study the question of financing the Agency's activities in the light of the views expressed and any other proposals that may be put forward; and
- (b) To report the results of this study to the General Conference at its seventh regular session.
