## Resolution adopted during the 71st plenary meeting on 26 September 1952

## THE AGENCY'S PROGRAMME IN NUCLEAR POTTER

## The General Conference,

(a) <u>Eaving received</u> the joint report by the Board of Governors and the Director General on steps taken pursuant to its resolution GC(V)/RES/ICS,

(b) <u>Having noted</u> with interest the statement made by the Director General at its sixth regular session, and

(c) <u>Appreciating</u> the steps taken by the Board of Governors and the Director General with regard to the Agency's programme in nuclear power within the framework of a long-term plan, and in particular the convening of a panel of experts on this subject in August 1962,

1. <u>Takes note</u> of the joint report of the Board of Governors and the Director General contained in document GC(VI)132; and

2. <u>Urges</u> the Board and the Director General, pending completion of the long-term plan under preparation, to continue to provide assistance to Member States pursuant to resolution GC(V)/RES/109.
