MUCLEAR POWER

<u>Resolution adopted during the Flat planary mooting</u> on 26 September 1962

JO-ORDINATION OF POWER QUESTIONS

The General Conference,

(a) <u>Conscious</u> of the important role that power is destined to play in economic progress and in industrialization of the developing countries, particularly during the development decade,

(b) <u>Taking into account</u> the gradually growing share that will fall to nuclear power in that development, and

(c) <u>Noting</u> the need for increased attention by the United Fations, the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency to problems of power in general,

1. <u>Urges</u> the Board of Governors and the Director General to take steps with a view to exploring ways and means of establishing a closer co-operation between the Agency, the United Nations, the specialized agencies and the World Power Conference in matters of power in general and of componies of power in particular, so as to achieve by joint effort a higher degree of co-ordination and efficiency in these important fields; and

2. <u>Reducests</u> the Beard and the Director General to submit to the General Conference at its seventh regular session a report on the progress achieved in that direction.
